Ordinance # 4:2020

Controlling Traffic on Village of Coney Island Streets


- 3-1: The Board of Trustees shall place and maintain traffic control signs and devices when and as required under the traffic ordinances of the Village to make effective the provisions of said ordinances, and may place and maintain such additional traffic control devices as board may deem necessary to regulate traffic under the traffic ordinances of the City or under state law or to guide or warn traffic.
- 3-2: The driver of any vehicle shall obey the instructions of any official traffic control device applicable thereto placed in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, unless otherwise directed by police officer, subject to a waiver for emergency vehicles which shall drive in a prudent and safe manner.
- 3-3 All traffic control signs and devices shall conform to the manual and specifications approved by the state highway commission or resolution adopted by the Village of Coney Island Board of Trustees.
- 4-1: No person shall, without lawful authority, attempt to or in fact alter, deface, injure, knock down or remove any official traffic control device or any signal or any part thereof.

Ordinance #3 & 4 were review and amended.
