ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT CAMPING OR SLEEPING IN VEHICLES ON THE VILLAGE OF CONEY ISLAND ROADS.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF CONEY ISLAND, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In order to promote the tranquility of the residents of the Village of Coney Island it shall be illegal for any person or persons to park a vehicle on the roads of the Village of Coney Island for the purpose of camping or sleeping in said vehicle overnight without obtaining written permission to do so by the Village of Coney Island. Such permission shall not be considered permanent but will be issued for a specified length of time.

Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of \$250.00 and/or impoundment of vehicle.

SECTION 2: The effective date of this ordinance shall be upon passage.
